BIBLE STORY

Easter Matthew 26:20-50: 27:1-2; 28:1-7

REMEMBER THIS

"I am alive for ever and ever!" Revelation 1:18. NIV

SAY THIS

Who is alive? Jesus is alive!

ACTIVITY

WHAT YOU NEED:

Music player, "He's Alive Oh Yeah" song (available on Spotify® or iTunes®) or other preschool music

WHAT YOU DO:

Play the song and encourage the children to sing and dance to the music. Stop the music and say, "Jesus is alive!" Then, re-start the music. Do it again!

WHAT YOU SAY:

"In today's story, we learned about the true story of Easter. Jesus went away and came back just like He said He would. Jesus is alive. Who is alive? Jesus is alive."

PRAYER

"Dear God,

We celebrate that Jesus is Your Son. We celebrate that Jesus died and came back, just like He said He would. We celebrate that Jesus is alive and He wants to be our friend forever.

Thank You for Jesus, God! We love You. In Jesus' name, amen."

BIBLE STORY

Jesus is alive!

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KEY QUESTION

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CREATE

an activity that allows preschoolers to review the Bible story, bottom line, or memory verse by creating a craft to take home

2. ONE, TWO, THREE!

WHAT YOU NEED: "Jesus by the Tomb" Activity Page; cardstock; wide painter's tape; and one of the following: dot markers, watercolors, or crayons

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Make one copy of "Jesus by the Tomb" for each child. DURING THE ACTIVITY: Give each child one copy of "Jesus by the Tomb" and a piece of wide painter's tape. Show the children how to cover Jesus with one long strip of tape going from the top to the bottom of the page. Next, instruct the children to use the dot markers, watercolors, or crayons to color the tomb picture. Once the children are done adding color, count to three together and remove the tape to reveal Jesus is alive!

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: (Give each child a "Jesus by the Tomb" Activity Page.) "This is a picture of Jesus from our Bible story."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Do you remember how something very, very sad happened to Jesus? (Allow children to respond.) Yes, people hurt Jesus so bad that He died. Jesus' friends put His body in a tomb and rolled a big stone in front of it.

(Give each child a piece of tape and show them how to put it over Jesus and the opening of the tomb.)

"We're going to pause our story for a minute while you add some color to your

(Allow the children to use dot markers, watercolors, or crayons to add color to their tomb scene.)

"Looks like you're ready for the BEST part of the story. Grab the bottom of your tape. Now, when we count to three, I want you to slowly peel the tape off of your picture. Got it? Okay, after Jesus' friends put His body in the tomb, something AMAZING happened! On the third day, Jesus came back! Count with me and pull your tape off when we say three. Here we go! One, two, THREE!" (The children should take the tape off of their pictures.)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Jesus is alive! Who is alive? Jesus is alive! Who is alive? Jesus is alive! Yay! Jesus is alive!"
