BIBLE STORY God Gave His Only Son (John 3:16)

REMEMBER THIS

"Nothing at all can ever separate us from God's love." Romans 8:39, NIrV

SAY THIS Who loves you? God loves me.

WHAT YOU NEED:

Paper plates, crayons, green construction paper, soissors, glue sticks, pencil

WHAT YOU DO:

Trace your child's hand on the green construction paper and cut it out, or have child cut it out if able. Color the paper plate blue. Glue paper hand to the center of the plate. Draw a heart in the middle of their hand cutout.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"In our story, we learned that God loves me and you, and everyone in the whole wide world! God loves the world so much that He gave us Jesus to be our friend forever. Who loves you? God loves me."




(Point to Jesus and wait for the children to find their match.)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "You can use your story cards to tell other people the good news that God loves us so much He gave us Jesus! Who loves you? God loves me!"



Parent Note: Your child used story cards to retell today's Bible story. Play a game by mixing them up and putting them in order again. You can also use them to retell the story to one another. Say, "God loved (heart symbol) the world (world symbol) so much He gave (gift symbol) us Jesus (Jesus symbol). (John 3:16)"
